

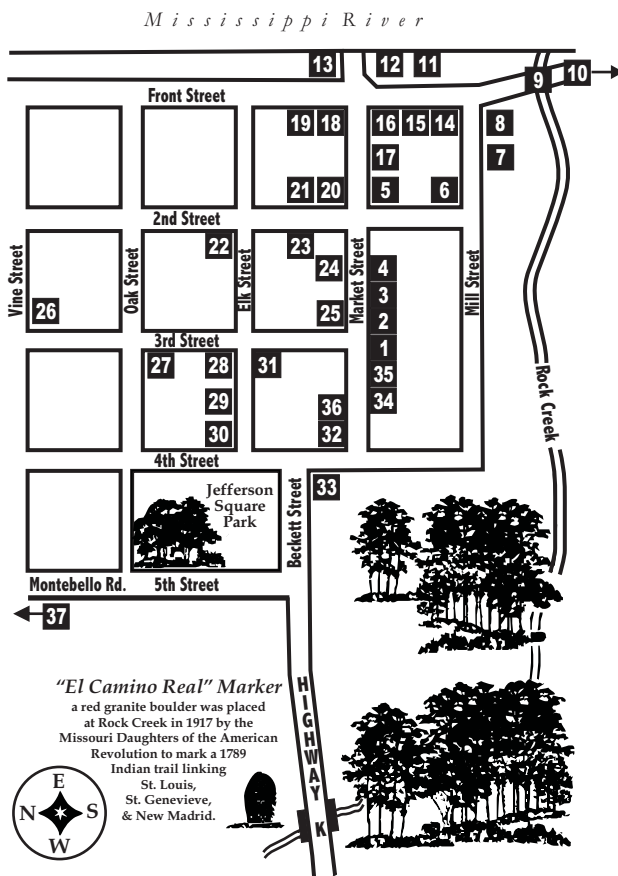
# Welcome to Historic Kimmswick

Enjoy the hospitality of our restaurants, the wide variety of goods in our many gift shops and galleries, or relax in a comfortable Bed and Breakfast.

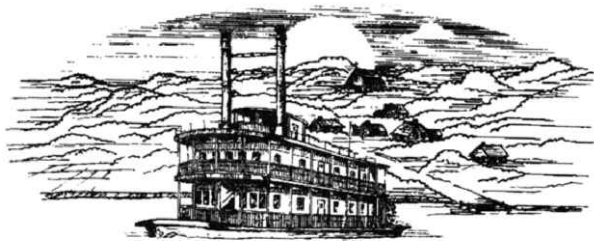
Forty four buildings within the seven block commercial district have been recently added to the National Registry of Historic Places.

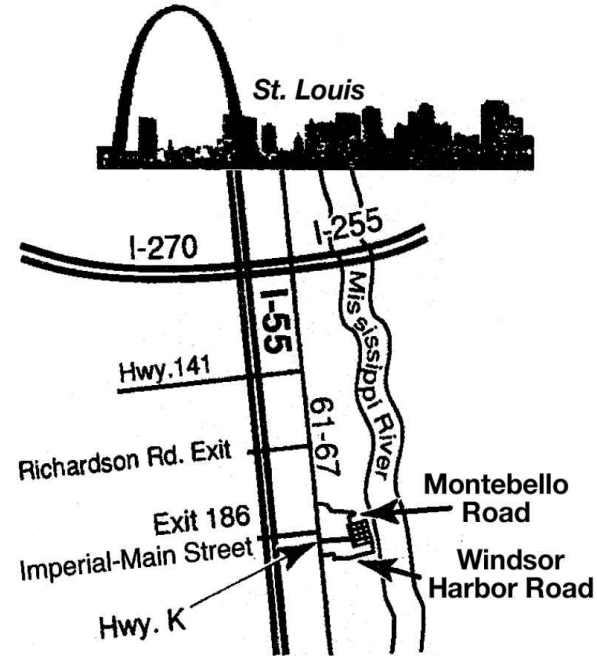
